

**RESOLUTION
R 175 - 11 / 12**

2012 SALES TAX HOLIDAY

WHEREAS, Act 2006-574 enacted by the Alabama Legislature during the 2006 Regular Session, generally referred to as the *State Sales Tax Holiday Legislation*, provides for an annual State Sales Tax Holiday exempting certain covered items from sales and use tax during the first full weekend in August; *and*

WHEREAS, in previous years the City of Selma has acted in conformity therewith passing resolutions exempting "covered items" from municipal sales and use tax during the same period, beginning at 12:01 a.m. on the first Friday of the month of August and ending at twelve midnight on Sunday of the same weekend as set forth within Act 2006-574; *and*

WHEREAS, the City of Selma desires to grant the allowance of a Sales Tax Holiday for the current year, exempting certain "covered items" from municipal sales and use tax during the period beginning at 12:01 a.m. on Friday, August 3, 2012 and ending at 12:00 midnight on Sunday, August 5, 2012; *and*

WHEREAS, the 2012 Sales Tax Holiday shall be subject to all terms, conditions, definitions, time periods, and rules as provided by Act 2006-574, except that the time period shall be limited as set forth within this resolution and not for all years thereafter.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SELMA AS FOLLOWS:

There shall be a 2012 Sales Tax Holiday exempting certain "covered items" from municipal sales and use tax during the **period beginning at 12:01 a.m. on Friday, August 3, 2012 and ending at 12:00 midnight on Sunday, August 5, 2012**, subject to all terms, conditions, definitions, time periods, and rules as provided by Act 2006-574, except that the time period shall be limited as set forth within this resolution and not for all years thereafter.




